DESCRIPTION:

Past research has shown that the transportation system plays a critical role in the country's economic growth by making and enhancing connections between individuals and firms, thus improving the business climate and overall economic growth. However, the relationship between the system and economic growth is complex. The extent of the system's contribution is dependent on how efficient it operates, how well it connects communities and people with resources and services, the physical condition of the infrastructure. The four presentations in this session will explore issues surrounding the relationship between mobility, accessibility, and productivity.

The presenters of this session are committee members of the Transportation Research Board (TRB). TRB provides innovative, research-based solutions to improve transportation.
