Argentina New Public-Private Partnership (PPP) Projects: Plans and Tenders

OBJECTIVE

As the third largest economy in Latin America, Argentina has solid prospects for sustainable growth. Due to the strong development potential in its transport sector, the country is deploying the most ambitious infrastructure plan in its history. In this context, a new framework for Public-Private Partnerships has been launched in the road sector to encourage an effective execution of projects that will help improve the lives of millions of Argentinians through a dynamic cooperation with private investment.

The Government of Argentina, through the PPP Unit in its Ministry of Finance, launched a broad framework that encourages projects within the PPP regime in key areas such as Energy, Water & Housing, Health & Education, and Transport. Specifically, the projects in the road sector have been developed on the basis of core principles: transparency, professionalism, teamwork, efficiency, and competitiveness.

This Special Session focuses on presenting these ambitious PPP road projects considered in the Federal Road Plan, including detailed information of planned stages, requirements, and public tender processes and due dates.
