#### Introduction:

Through the IRF YP we have had the opportunity to get experiences and knowledge that comes from the perspective and experience of young professionals from around the world. Even though the problems are different for each country and city, we have identified certain challenges that cut through multiple cultures and backgrounds.

## Objective:

To listen to some of these experiences and be able to map Road Safety priorities and challenges from around the world that should be considered by specialists, governments and civil society from every country.

#### Structure:

We will enlist and prioritize the challenges through a participatory method. These will be the general layout of the session:

- We will give time for speakers to present their papers (30 minutes / 5 minutes each and 5 for Q&A)
- We will divide into groups to discuss the main challenges that were presented conceptually (15 minutes)
- We will come back to the group to present each group's list and we will prioritize it as a group (15 minutes)
- We will define such concepts, so they can be adopted and envisioned in any Road Safety related project/programme (30 minutes)
